Canadian National Exhibition Association Archives Fee Schedule Film Reproductions

Preserved (conserved and duplicated) motion picture material for which the CNEA Archives holds copyright, may be reproduced for a fee.

When the CNEA Archives does not hold copyright on motion picture material in its holdings, the CNEA Archive will help the user identify copyright owners, but it is the user's responsibility to clear rights with the appropriate third parties. All fees are payable in advance.

A Fee Schedule is provided below. All prices are in Canadian dollars per second and the terms of all rights are non-exclusive for perpetuity. Fees for North American not-for-profit institutions are 50% of list fees. Fees are cumulative (per project, not per cut). Charges may be applied on rush orders during off-hours. Search fees may also apply in locating relevant footage. Customers will be advised before search commences. The Archives must be credited as the source of the material (staff of the Archives will assist in formulating proper citations).

Not-for-profit use:	\$50/image

Print runs:	\$150/image - for the first 1000 copies. \$50 for every 1000 copies after (Including, but not limited to books, brochures, advertisements, postcards, etc.)
